Sikalastic® Clearglaze is a clear, high-solids polyurethane coating that protects skylights and glazings against air, rain, hail, snow, and dirt ingress. Its transparent finish retains the appearance of the underlying substrate and still allows light to pass through. Combining toughness with excellent adhesion, Sikalastic® Clearglaze provides a great alternative to expensive replacement of leaking skylights while enhancing the shatter resistance of the original glass. Local reinforcement can repair existing cracks with limited blurring.

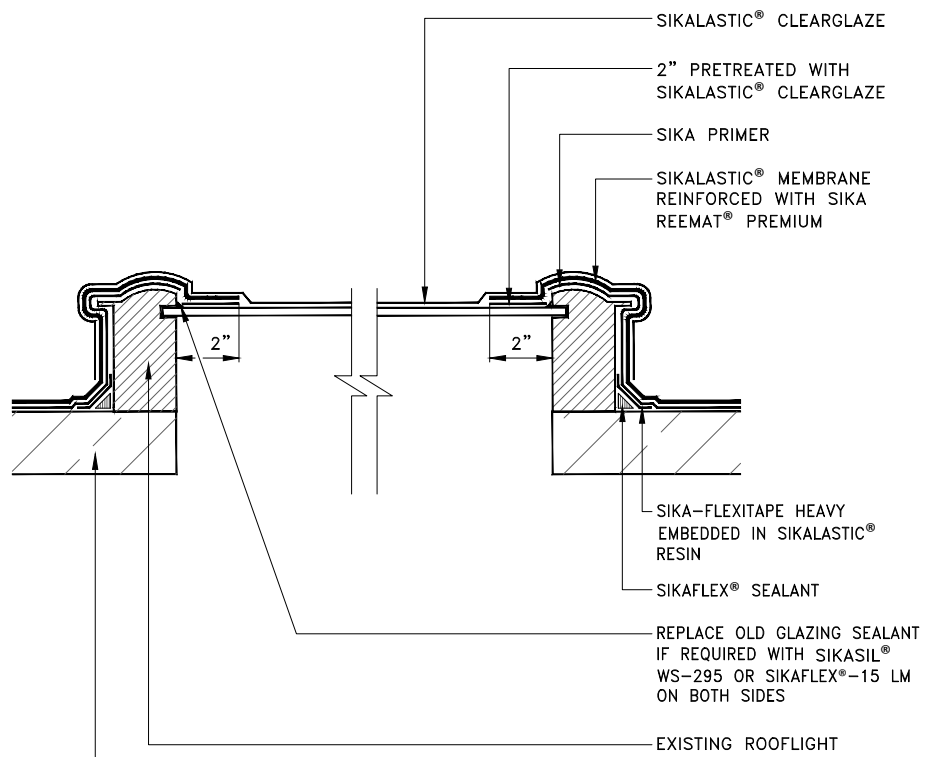
Skylight was protected with Sikalastic Clearglaze. After Hurricane Charlie, the skylights shattered but remained in place.

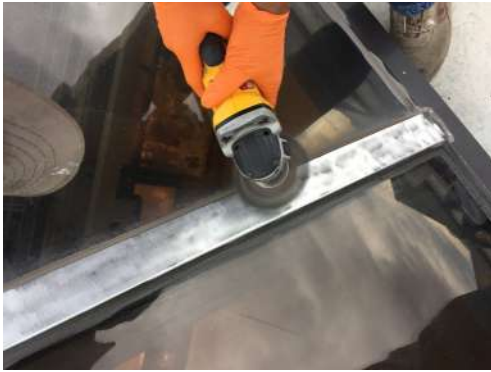

SYSTEM BUILD UP

Sikalastic® Clearglaze is typically applied in combination with a fully reinforced Sikalastic RoofPro membrane at the skylight frame and mullions (old joint sealants should be replaced prior to the application). The entire skylight including the frame is then over coated with 1 or 2 layers of Sikalastic® Clearglaze creating a completely seamless waterproofing membrane.



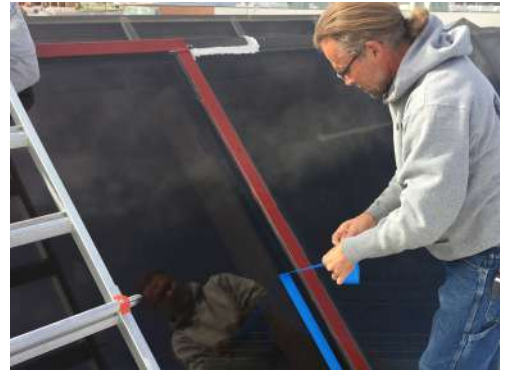
APPLICATION



Remove paint as required and solvent wipe glass to provide a sound surface to prime.



Prime frame and mullion with Sikalastic® EP Primer. Then, mask off skylight 2 inches from the mullion and prime glass with Sikalastic® Clearglaze.



Always pull the tape while the Sikalastic® Clearglaze is wet to leave a clean sharp edge.



Remask the picture frame and apply Sikalastic® RoofPro resin to the primed surface of the mullion and glass.



While the Sikalastic® RoofPro resin is wet lay in precut lengths of Sika reinforcing scrim and embed with a wet roller or brush to ensure full saturation and conformation to the substrate.



Sikalastic® Clearglaze is applied by foam roller at 20 mils WFT (80ft²/gal) per coat. Lap up onto the installed RoofPro membrane 2 inches butting up against the mullion.
